SUGAR BEARS NOTES...

- Central Arkansas (25-3, 14-0) will wrapup the season and try to remain perfect in Southland play with a pair of home matches at the Prince Center this weekend. The Sugar Bears host Sam Houston State (19-12, 11-3) on Thursday night and Lamar (13-12, 8-6) on Saturday afternoon.
- The Sugar Bears have clinched the regular season Southland Conference title. They will try to become the fourth team to go undefeated in the league since 1994.
- At 25-3, UCA has the eighth highest winning percentage in the country behind: #1 Penn State (26-0), #2 Texas (19-1), Florida International (26-2), #22 Northern Iowa (24-2), #11 Kentucky (24-2), #3 Hawaii (23-2) and #15 Florida State (23-2).
- Central Arkansas is 11-0 at the Prince Center this season, and have won 14 straight home matches, dating back to last season. Since 2005, the Sugar Bears are 52-10 in the Prince Center for a .839 winning percentage.
- The Sugar Bears have recorded 16 sweeps this year, breaking the old mark of 14 set in 2007 and 2008.
- UCA's Southland title is the program's first since winning the Arkansas Women's Intercollegiate Sports Association (AWISA) championship in 1977.
- The Sugar Bears' 25 wins is tied for the third most in school history and is the most since moving from NAIA to NCAA. The 1988 team went 34-14 and the '86 squad was 29-13.
- Sam Houston State is 19-12 and 11-3 in SLC play. They are fighting for the top seed in the Southland Conference tournament, as they are tied with Texas State. The Bearkats lost their last two matches – at UT Arlington and at Texas State last weekend.
- In Southland matches, the Bearkats rank seventh with a .178 hitting percentage and 11.95 kills per set. They lead the league with 17.16 digs per set.
- Senior middle blocker Anna Ferguson is third in SLC matches with 3.84 kills per set and sixth with a .297 hitting percentage. Sophomore outside hitter Carli Kolbe is fourth at 3.59 kps. Freshman libero Kaylee Hawkins leads the league at 5.24 digs.
- UCA is 2-1 all-time against Sam Houston State. UCA won last year's match in four sets at Huntsville.
- Lamar is 13-12 overall and 8-6 in league play. They are in third place in the West Division and would be the fourth seed in the SLC Tournament, heading into the weekend. They lost at UT Arlington and Texas State last weekend.
- The Lady Cardinals rank third in Southland play with a .226 hitting percentage and are fifth in kills at 12.29. They lead the league in aces with 1.58 per set.
- Freshman middle blocker Wendy Krell leads the league with a .346 hitting percentage. Senior Lauren Holdorf is fourth with a .308 attack rate. Freshman middle blocker Jayme Bazile is 50th in the nation and third in the Southland with 1.20 blocks per set.
- Lamar leads the all-time series with UCA 3-2. The Sugar Bears won last year's match in Beaumont in four sets.
- In conference play, UCA leads the league with 12.28 assists per game. They are also second in hitting percentage (.240) and kills (13.21).
- Senior setter Robyn Smith leads the Southland and is 17th in the nation with 11.37 assists per set. She is UCA's career leader with 5,071 assists and 11.58 per game. Smith reached the 1,000 dig plateau last week against McNeese State.
- Junior Chloe Smith ranks 16th in the nation with 4.51 kills per set. She has 419 kills this season, which is seventh most in school history. She would 51 kills in the final two matches to break UCA's record.
- Saturday will be the final match for UCA's four seniors – Evaree Franklin, Jennifer Hauskey, Robyn Smith and Amicha Williams.
- This is the last season of UCA's NCAA Division I transition period. Due to the transition, the Sugar Bears are not eligible for postseason play.
